# What to expect

When you first arrive, one of our staff will explain rules and eligibility requirements for our overnight dorm.

Our rules are in place to allow for a safe and orderly environment where we can provide care to those who need it. Inappropriate or disruptive behavior will not be permitted.

You will be scheduled for an individual meeting with our Director of Men's Ministry so that we can get to know you better. We will evaluate your needs and identify ways we can help, and will assist you in connecting with other agencies as needed.

We will work with you to set achievable goals and expect you to show that you are working toward them.
